Georgia Dear Parents its is with

you get this send me my wifes picture tell her to write
(Lewis Bourke is here)

send me a box as soon as you get this and send

me stuff that wont spoil some tobacco pipe and

some tin dishes cup pail plate knife fork
spoon

and every thing my pants & shirts coat

some shoes stockings blanket & pound of tea

and all the coffee you are a mind to buy paper

salt soda spider pocket knife & bottol of salisby
for sickness & butcher knife

or run a large cup and small one spoon tin
dishes all of them a quart pail and 6 yeast

send a lot of each kind write a good letter to me

send apple and vittles that will keep and what
1st bottol of Pepper Sams

els you are a mind to be shure and send them
I hat or care to send my old cloths to me
