Barre March 3, 1794 (edited)

The Inhabitants of the Town of Barre that are Qualified by Law to Vote in Town meetings are hereby required to meet at the Dwelling House of Calvin Smith in sd Town on Monday the 17th Day of March Instant at Eight O'Clock in the Morning then and there to act on the following Articles Viz

1st to Choose a Moderator to Govern sd Meeting

2 To Choose Town Officers for the ensuing year as the Law Directs

....

7 To Grant money to repair and make roads the Bridges the Current year

8 To Grant Money for Schooling the Current year or act thereon as they Shall think Proper

....

10 To Grant Money to Hire Preaching the Current year and act thereon as they Shall think Proper

11 To Choose A Committee to Hire Preaching the Current [year] or act thereon as they Shall think Proper

12 to hear the report of the Committee chosen to Lease out the Publick Lands or act thereon as they Shall think Proper

....

14 To See if the Town will Come into any method to Establish a Center in Town or act thereon as they Shall think Proper

....

16 To See if the Town will Erect some Cheap Log building in the Center of sd Town for the purpose of holding their meeting in to do Town Business and to meet in on Lords Day for the Publick Worship of God
