- (a) The **schools** soldiers attended before going off to war.
- (b) Your **Town Hall**, where citizens made decisions about the war regarding recruitment, support, bounties, survivor benefits.
- (c) **Train Station**, where soldiers caught trains heading south.
- (d) The **P.O.**, where families went to receive letters from the front.
- (e) The name of the **Post Master**.
- (f) **Stores**, where residents bought newspapers & shared news.
- (g) The **Doctor(s)**, who treated wounded soldiers when they returned.
- (h) The **Churches**, where soldiers' funerals were held.
- (i) The **cemeteries**, where Windsor's veterans are buried.
- (j) The **mills or manufactories** where guns, uniforms, and other goods were made to supply the war.
- (k) Find one more Civil War connection to your community.
