

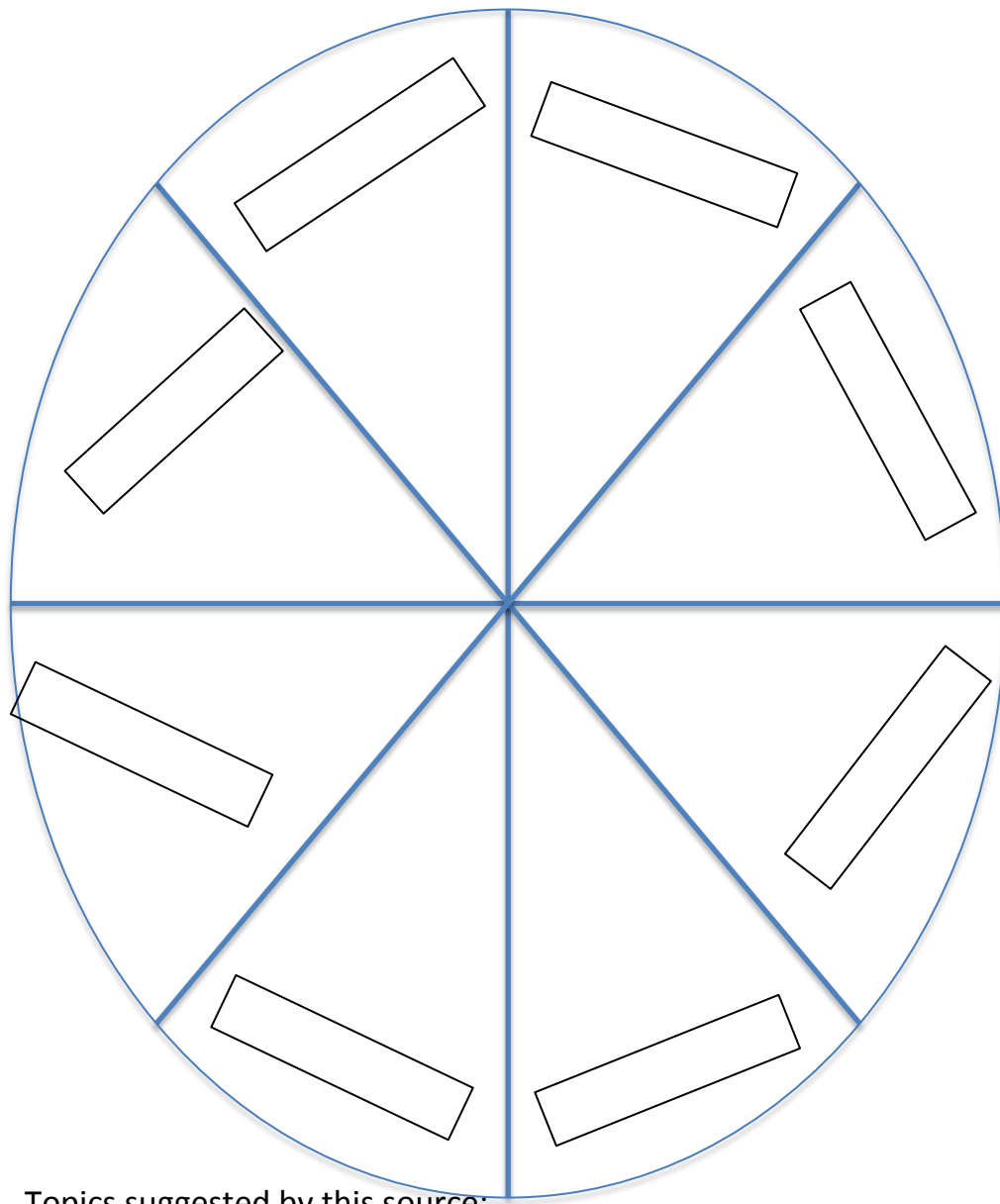
# Directions
