This day personally appeared before me M. J. Campbell
a Justice of the Peace in and for the County of Caroline and State of Virginia, John Goulden, whose name is signed to the foregoing statement, and made oath to the facts, that he is a Citizen of Caroline County and the State of Virginia, ^{and has always been a Citizen of Virginia} that he is the legal owner, in his own right, of the slaves, David, Caroline, Wade, George, Steven, Henry, William, Ann, Mary, Rachael, Hannah, Edmund, Eliza, Sally, Abigail, Susan, Fether, Humphrey, Ned G, Ned Calh, Peter, Bob, Armstrong, Louisa, Adeline, Eliza, Edward, Milly & Francis, mentioned in the foregoing statement, and that they are worth the sum of Thirty three thousand and nine hundred dollars (\$33,900.00); that the said slaves were induced away and abducted by the enemy from him about the 15th June 1862, and have been and are now harbored by the enemy and lost to him the J. Goulden; and that none of the aforesaid slaves have returned, but all of them have been and are now lost to him.

The evidence of Edmund Sale, who was duly sworn, taken before me
a Justice of the Peace in and for the County of Caroline and State of Virginia, and by me reduced to writing -
I am a Citizen of Caroline County and the State of Virginia, and reside on the farm adjoining to John Goulden, whose affidavit and statement is appended, I have managed for Mr Goulden several years and know his slaves well. I know him to be a Citizen of the State of Virginia, ^{and has been for many years} that he was in his own right, the legal owner

of the slaves, Daniel, Caroline, Wade, George, Steven, Henry, William
Ann, Mary, Rachel, Hannah, Edmund, Walt, Sally, Alex. Andrew, Arthur
Humphrey, Ned G, Ned Sale, Peter, Bob, Simons, London, Adaline,
Eliza, Edward, Mily, and Francis, mentioned in the foregoing statement
that the sd slaves, were induced away, and abducted from the sd
Gouldin by the enemy, about the 15th June 1862, and lost to him,
that the sd slaves, have been and are now harbored by the
enemy, that none of the sd slaves mentioned above have been returned
to the sd Gouldin, I assisted in valuing the aforesaid slaves as
listed, and consider their worth the sums opposite their
respective names, and in the aggregate worth Thirty three
thousand and nine hundred dollars. (\$33,900.00)

Since the time the sd slaves were abducted, the enemy
were in possession and occupancy of the Rappahannock River adjoining
the sd Gouldin farm, and their scouts were at his house

appears above, I am well acquainted with the sd Gouldin's slaves,
I know him to be a citizen of the State of Virginia, and that he
was the legal owner in his own right of the slaves, Daniel, Caroline
Wade, George, Steven, Henry, William, Ann, Mary, Rachel, Hannah
Edmund, Walt, Sally, Alex. Andrew, Arthur, Humphrey, Ned G,
Ned Sale, Peter, Bob, Simons, London, Adaline, Eliza, Edward,
Mily, and Francis, mentioned in the foregoing statement, that the
sd slaves were induced away, and abducted from the sd Gouldin
by the enemy, about the 15th day of June 1862, and lost to him
that the sd slaves, have been and are now harbored by the enemy
